

To thee Cherubin and Seraphin continually do cry: Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of Sabaoth. Heaven and earth are full of the Majesty of thy glory. The glorious company of the Apostles, the goodly fellowship of the Prophets, the noble army of Martyrs praise thee; the holy Church throughout all the world doth acknowledge thee the Father of infinite Majesty, venerating thine honorable, true, and only Son, also the Holy Ghost, the Comforter.
